Delivered at the start of the school day, these circuits promote focus, concentration, and emotional readiness in the classroom.

Our sessions focus on:

Alerting Movements - To stimulate the central nervous system.

Organising Activities - To build balance, coordination, and body awareness.

Calming Exercises - To support regulation and readiness to learn.

Flexible Delivery:

Suitable for the whole class, small groups or individual pupils.

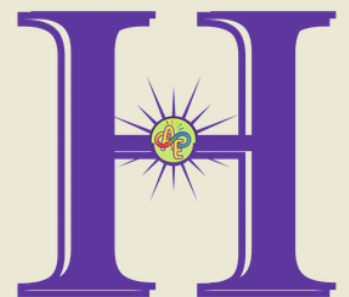
