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Admission Criteria:

Children and Young People in Key Stage 1 and 2, aged 5-11 years. These are individuals who are struggling in mainstream education whether with diagnosed or undiagnosed needs such as ASD/ADHD/Dyspraxia or other neurodivergence/SEMH, and who may be at risk of permanent exclusion from a school setting.

Minimum 4 weeks to Full Academic Year. While a final progression review is conducted at the conclusion of your child or young person's time in our provision, we also offer termly reviews as needed to support development.
