- Space Considerations: Workshops are designed for a limited number of children, ensuring that each participant receives the attention they need, with activities tailored to their sensory and spatial needs.

Parent/Guardian Guidelines:

Parents or guardians will not be in the workshop space but must remain nearby in case of an emergency or to provide comfort. For example, the UFO Café is a nearby, accessible area where parents can relax while staying within reach.

STEMEX staff and Autism Explorers facilitators will oversee the workshop, ensuring that each child is supported throughout the session.
